



OUR FEES AND SERVICES GUIDE ON PROBATE MATTERS

We can assist with obtaining the Grant of Probate only in an estate. This service is based on you providing date of death valuations for all assets and liabilities in the estate, and all required information for the application. This service does not include the provision of any additional advice in relation to the estate administration.

How much does this service cost?

Where there is no inheritance tax payable, there are no transferable inheritance tax allowances to be claimed and the executors do not need to submit an account to HMRC; typically we charge a fixed fee of £1,850 (plus VAT)

Breakdown of costs:

Our legal fees	£ 1,850
VAT on our fees	£ 370
Disbursements	See below

If we are required to claim transferable allowances then there will be an additional cost of £500 plus VAT.

Disbursements comprise:

- probate court fee of £300 plus £16 for each office copy Grant of Probate required;
- identification checks at £20 plus VAT per executor

What Are Disbursements?

Disbursements are costs related to your matter that are payable to third parties, such as court fees. We handle the payment of disbursements on your behalf to ensure a smoother process.

As part of our fixed fee we will:

- provide you with a dedicated and experienced probate lawyer to work on your matter;
- identify the legally appointed executors or administrators
- accurately identify the type of Probate application you will require;
- complete the Probate Application and a schedule of the assets in the estate;
- make the application to the Probate Registry on your behalf;
- obtain the Probate and securely send copies to you;

On average, estates that fall within this category are dealt with within 3-6 months.
